- 1.0 bilingual teacher aide that was brought in to assist students that have academic issues due to language barriers. These issues have been magnified due to COVID.
 - 30,000
- 1.0 Interventionist brought in to deal with social/emotional issues which have been impacted greatly due to the pandemic.
 - 106,000
- Additional iPads and Chromebooks for our low-income students to help them have access to technology.
 - 30,000
- Ivy League After School Program started to help close gaps due to the pandemic.
